Unitec Recycling Corp. assumes ownership and full responsibility for the media it collects. Upon pick up and return to its secure facility, an inventory of collected equipment begins in usually one to two business days. Inventories are documented (i.e. hardware make, model, serial no. etc.) on to spreadsheets and begin the process for data eradication (destruction). The correlated documentation and all certificates of disposal, transfer of ownership and other legalese are begun within of 30 days of retrieval.

URC employs the overwriting hard drive wiping as well as degaussing various media in accordance to the D.O.D. eradication processes specified as DOD 5220.22-M as specified in NIPS Operating Manual (NIPSOM) as followed by the Departments of Defense, Energy, Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the CIA.

URC accepts all electronic equipment and devices excepting microwave radioactive propelled machinery CRT monitors are accepted for a nominal fee based on inches 15", 17", 19" due to IL EPA processing requirements. There is a fee for customized data eradication. We are able to customize to a variety of our customers recycling needs and questions are always welcome. In 2008 Unitec Recycling Corp. with guidance and consultation from the IL Dept of Natural Resources initiated the preliminary steps toward Phase 1 of ISO 14001 Certification. URC continues to monitor technology advancement and update its practices regarding data security and data elimination.
